



...lies in the wheels

1. Buff the Scout Truck wheels with fine sand paper to remove burrs. A tool to spin wheels on a drill is available at the Scout Shop
2. Buff the nails used as axles with steel wool. The nails can be placed in a drill as if they were drill-bits to be spun while you buff them.
3. Make sure the nails are inserted so as to be parallel with the ground.
4. Make sure that all the wheels touch the ground.
5. Use one drop of oil for each wheel.
6. Make sure the wheels spin freely and don't rub on the body of the Scout Truck
